- Identify the strategies and activities with the greatest impact on outcomes and allocate resources accordingly while balancing internal and external stakeholder needs.
- Directly manage administrative staff and volunteers
- Provide monthly operational and fiscal reports to the Shura Chairperson and attend the Shura meeting.
- Be the main representative and correspondent for the IAR in external affairs.
- Refine and update a list of short term and long term strategic activities of the IAR and present annually to the Shura.
- Be a liaison between the IAR, other organizations and external media.
- The CEO shall have the power and authority to exercise all the rights, powers and authority on all operation matters and in accordance with IAR Constitution.
